Film Club:

Each month we present a film from the Madelyn Osur Film Library on the screen at Rocky Mountain Women's Film office inside the Lincoln School. These screenings are free and open to the public.

Filmmaker LIVE!:

The highlight at each Festival is often the direct interaction with filmmakers. As an extension of this connection, we host special screenings throughout the year that will include a Q&A with the filmmaker, LIVE!.

Film in the Community:

In partnership with community organizations, RMWF provides free screenings of films to expose diverse and new audiences to entertaining and thought-provoking documentary film.
