

RMWF Drive-In Cinema Policies

1. PARKING RULES:

- ☐ All cars will be directed to specific parking spot at the discretion of the lot staff. Large or tall vehicles will be guided to park on the sides or back of the lot.
- Once parked, you may not drive away until instructed by event staff at the end of the film program.
- □ No engine idling: Because we park cars closely together, your engine exhaust will affect the safety of others. You may start your engine periodically to keep the battery fresh, but for no more than one minute.

2. NO CARS CAN ENTER OR LEAVE ONCE THE LOT IS CLOSED

For the safety of our staff and patrons, cars will not be admitted to the lot after the posted close time, nor will cars be able to leave because of the parking layout. Lot open/close times are posted on the ticketing website.

3. EVENT AUDIO REQUIRES FM RADIO

All films are broadcast and can be heard in your car using your FM Radio. If your car is not equipped with a radio, we recommended bringing one. You cannot tune into the signal with a smartphone. The frequency will be given to you at check-in. Films will be shown with Open Captions when made available by the filmmaker. There are no loudspeakers.

4. WEATHER

- ☐ In the event of a rain forecast, we may announce an event cancellation by 5:00pm on the day of the event.

 Registered attendees will be notified of a rain date.
- ☐ In the event of rain during the movie, please shelter in your car. Cars will not be allowed to exit the lot until it is safe to do so, and only under the direction of lot staff.

5. COVID-19 POLICIES:

RMWF will follow state and county guidelines in managing this event.

6. RESTROOMS

7. FOOD AND BEVERAGE

- ☐ The possession, consumption or usage of alcohol or drugs is not permitted at this event. RMWF reserves the right to refuse admittance or ask any party to leave that violates this policy.
- Concessions will not be available at this event. Please bring anything you'd like to enjoy during the film.
- You must remove any trash you bring in or create during the film. There are no public waste receptacles available.
