



## RMWF Drive-In Cinema Policies

### 1. REFUNDS OR EXCHANGES:

No refunds or exchanges. If you cannot use your reservation, we recommend giving it to a friend to use.

### 2. PARKING RULES:

- All cars must park facing forward and will be directed to specific spot at the discretion of the lot staff. Large or tall vehicles will be guided to park on the sides or back of the lot.
- Once parked, you may not drive away until instructed by event staff at the end of the film program.
- No engine idling: Because we park cars closely together, your engine exhaust will affect the safety of others. You may start your engine periodically to keep the battery fresh, but for no more than one minute.

### 3. NO CARS CAN ENTER OR LEAVE ONCE THE LOT IS CLOSED.

For the safety of our staff and patrons, cars will not be admitted to the lot after the posted close time, nor will cars be able to leave because of the parking layout. Lot open/close times are posted on the ticketing website.

### 4. EVENT AUDIO REQUIRES FM RADIO

All films are broadcast and can be heard in your car using your FM Radio. If your car is not equipped with a radio, we recommended bringing one. You cannot tune into the signal with a smartphone. The frequency will be given to you at check-in. Films will be shown with Open Captions when made available by the filmmaker. There are no loudspeakers.

### 5. WEATHER

- In the event of a rain forecast, we may announce an event cancellation by 5:00pm on the day of the event. Your ticket can be used as a credit for a future RMWF event.
- In the event of rain during the movie, please shelter in your car. Cars will not be allowed to exit the lot until it is safe to do so, and only under the direction of lot staff.

6. THE FOLLOWING SOCIAL DISTANCING POLICIES HAVE BEEN ADOPTED:

- ❑ Once parked, you must watch the film from inside of your vehicle. There is no picnicking on the grounds, nor on your car's roof, hood, truck, or truck's bed.
- ❑ When outside your vehicle or interacting with event staff, we ask that you keep a safe social distance of 6' and that you wear a face covering.

7. RESTROOMS

- ❑ A porta potty will be available, although we request that is only used if absolutely necessary and for the health and safety of everyone.
- ❑ Staff will manage any line that forms, keeping parties 6' apart.
- ❑ Hand sanitizer will be made available.
- ❑ Please follow social distancing protocols getting to and from the porta potty.

8. FOOD AND BEVERAGE

- ❑ The possession, consumption or usage of alcohol or drugs is not permitted at this event. RMWF reserves the right to refuse admittance or ask any party to leave that violates this policy.
- ❑ Concessions will not be available at this event. Please plan accordingly and bring anything you'd like to enjoy during the film program.
- ❑ You must remove any trash you bring in or create during the film. There are no public waste receptacles available.
